Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 starting at 9.30am – entrance will be from the playground gate.

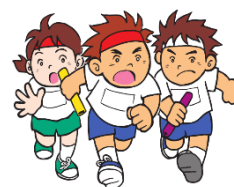
Key Stage 2 starting at 1.15pm – entrance will be from the playground gate

Our exiting Year 6 received their SAT results recently and they were amazing. The national average for the combined reading, writing and maths pass rate was 59%. All 3 of our schools attained much higher
