The Early Years (Nursery and Reception) will hold their disco in the Nursery

This ensures that our younger children are not overwhelmed by large groups of children.

Children can attend in their party clothes or in a Halloween fancy dress themed costume. There will be a prize for the best Halloween dressed member of each class.

If you wish for your child to attend please return them to their NORMAL SCHOOL ENTRY POINT at 4.30pm on Monday 23rd October 2023. A register will then be taken in each class – children must bring their ticket with them to gain entry.

At the end of the disco at 6pm all children MUST be collected by someone from their contact permission sheet. Children will NOT be allowed to walk home alone after this event.
